Participates in administrative and clinical work related to planning, directing, and managing all aspects of outpatient teletherapy services. Manages and oversees staff development.

As a therapist will provide independent diagnostic, psycho-social and professional assessment, treatment recommendations and counseling for children and adults with mental health and co-occurring disorders- with an appropriate level of supervision.
