Coastal Horizons currently has a position for a Child and Family Therapist for our PPW (Pregnant and Postpartum Women's Program) in our Columbus County location.

PPW Child and Family Therapist will provide parenting and family support to program clients and their children, as well as provides parent-child treatment to program clients and their children. Completes child-centered clinical assessment, and utilizes all available information to develop a thoughtful, well-integrated clinical formulation and identify parent-child areas of strength and areas of need. Develops a comprehensive Child and Family Plan of Care. Uses a variety of clinical modalities, including family therapy approaches, attachment-based approaches, and behavioral strategies, that are age-appropriate, relationship-based, and trauma-informed. Engages with both the caregiver and child in a supportive, reflective, and exploratory manner. Also, collaborates as part of an interdisciplinary team and provide best care and support to needs of client, her child(ren) and her family in support of family preservation.

The PPW Child and Family Therapist also:

- Provides independent diagnostic and psycho-social evaluations and therapy services which focus on complicated mental health issues (parent and child), family issues, parenting issues, childhood issues, adolescent issues, and substance abuse and additional issues.
- Provides office and home-based psychotherapeutic interventions and special activities for children and their caregivers using a variety of clinical modalities.
- Utilizes a two-generation perspective and helps the parent gain insight regarding personal history, feelings for the child, and current parenting practices.

Qualification/ Skills:

Education: Graduation from a four-year college or university in human services or related field. Graduation from a Master's Degree Program in counseling or related human services field preferred.

- Master's or Doctorial level mental health provider (LCSW, LMFT, clinical psychologist)
